

For you who are a victim of theft or have lost your things

The Copenhagen Police Department can help you if you have been a victim of theft or have lost your things during your stay in Copenhagen.

When you arrive at the police station, you will have to inform the police employee about the episode and describe your lost/stolen things. In connection with your report to the Copenhagen Police, you will be issued a receipt. The receipt can be used to document the incident for your insurance company or in order to apply for an emergency travel document/passport.

If your passport or ID-card has been stolen/lost, the police will report it disappeared in an international database to avoid misuse.

POLICE STATION.

If you wish to report a theft or lost items to the police, you must come to the police station that is located at Copenhagen Central Station.

Opening hours:

Weekdays: 08.00 – 21.00

Weekend og Holidays: 10.00 – 17.00

Please note that you will be entering the police station through a double lock system. Only the victim and optionally one relative will be granted access to the room.

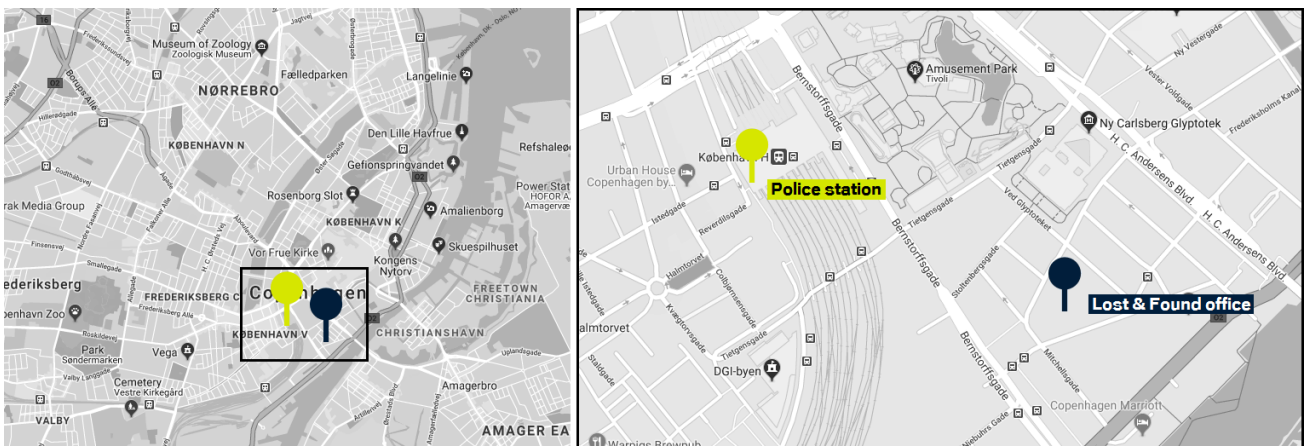
